Life Cycle of a Green bean plant

We ended our last theme talking about healthy food for our bodies. Now, we have started a new theme: "Is It Alive?" which is focused on three important topics:

- ❖ Is It Alive? (Difference between living and non-living things)
- ❖ Basic needs of living things: Food (energy), Water, Shelter and Air.
- ❖ Life Cycle

At the end of the theme (in about 2 weeks) we will start the final projects in which you will participate with your child creating a three-dimensional representation of the life cycle of a chosen living creature. This will be done in the classroom, so the day you choose to come in, you will work with your child.

These projects will be done with recyclable materials, so you can send to school all you have such as: empty plastic bottles, old pieces of fabric, paper, boxes, magazines and anything useful you want to get rid of.

The week before we start the projects, your child will choose his\her favorite living thing and together, you will investigate about its life cycle. After that, your child will draw a sketch for his project and then you will come and work with him/her here at school.

After everyone finishes their projects, we will have a special museum exposition for the school.
